What Information Do We Collect?

- NHUM obtains information about its donors through; mail, e-mail, fax and telephone contact. Donors provide; name, address, phone numbers, IP address and credit card numbers if the donor uses this method of donating.

How Do We Use This Information

- Name and address information we receive from children's (and staff) sponsors is passed along to the sponsorship staff at the Kasana Children's Center in Uganda East Africa for their use in establishing communication between the sponsor and sponsored child (or sponsored staff member). Credit card information remains in the South Dakota office and is never shared or sent overseas.
- Information we receive from missionary support donors is sent along to the missionary being supported (or their representative in the USA) so they can keep a record of donors for their personal accounts and to include the donor on their prayer letter list. The information sent to the missionary includes donors name, address and amount donated, credit card information is not provided to the missionary.
- Information about donors who provide funds for designated projects or specific 'need items' may be provided to staff members in the department utilizing the funds but information is limited to name, address and fund designation.
- Staff members in the U.S. and in Uganda are only provided donor information on a 'need to know' basis.

It is the policy of New Hope Uganda Ministries, Inc. and New Hope Uganda (NGO) not to share donor information with any other organization or individual except as required by law and governmental agencies having clear jurisdiction in such matters. Any direct donor contact from individuals (Ugandan Nationals) in Uganda East Africa, except NHUM or NHU staff or as provided for in our sponsorship program, should be considered unauthorized and forwarded to the NHUM office in South Dakota.
