

The Need

Our Kobwin Children's Center is in a remote area of Uganda and we currently rely upon a few inconsistent and expensive solar panels and for light in the evening we use petroleum lights which pose both a health and safety risk. The unreliable electricity makes simple things like studying in the evening or making a phone call difficult.

We now have the opportunity to connect to the Ugandan power supply. Connecting to this power supply would help our students with their academic studies and we could expand our vocational training to include welding and fabrication.

"There is no light for reading books during night time. With electricity, we will be able to learn after dark."

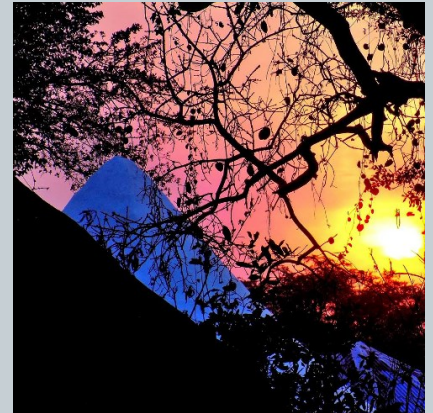
