Musana Camps Scholarships



The Need

Uganda has a monumental orphan crisis with 3 million orphans. While many see the orphans as the problem, New Hope Uganda recognizes the deeply-rooted cultural sickness, and the orphan situation is a severe symptom.

What is this sickness? Simply put, it is a sin-ravaged culture where the Biblical design for family has been essentially destroyed. For example, in Uganda, manhood can be defined by the number of wives he has and womanhood by the number of children she has. Therefore, we see a lot of polygamy and absent father homes. Often times, children are abandoned or raised by extended family such as grandparents.

New Hope Uganda understands that societal transformation through the power of the Gospel of Jesus Christ is the only solution to the problem of fatherlessness in Uganda and around the world.

To address these deep-rooted cultural distortions of family, we began Musana Camps, where we teach young adults about Biblical manhood and womanhood, preparing them for a future grounded in life-giving truth. Our camp program is called "Rites of Passage Experiences" or ROPES.
